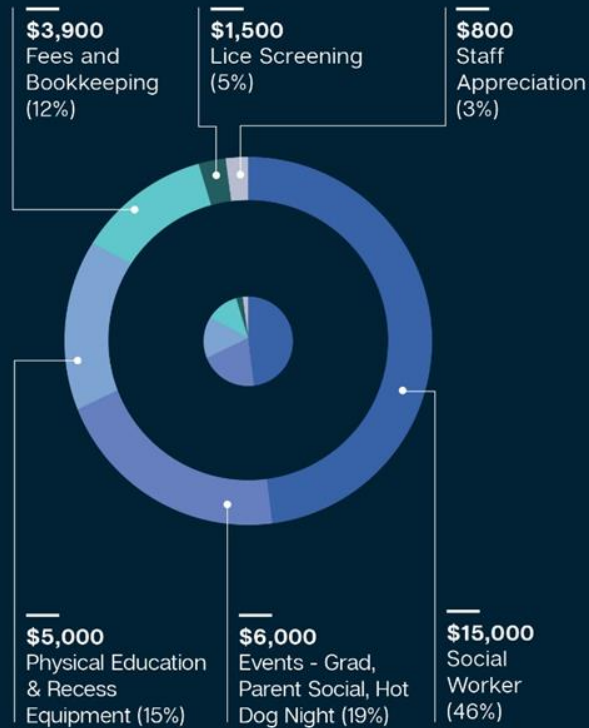

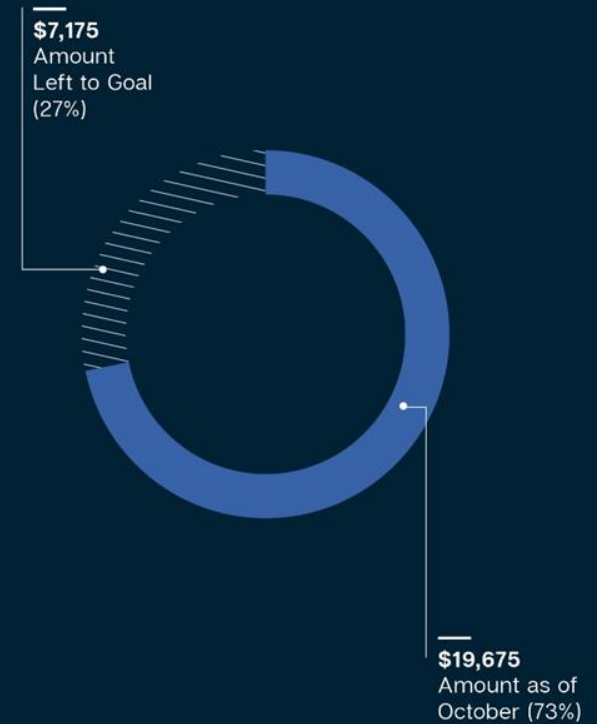

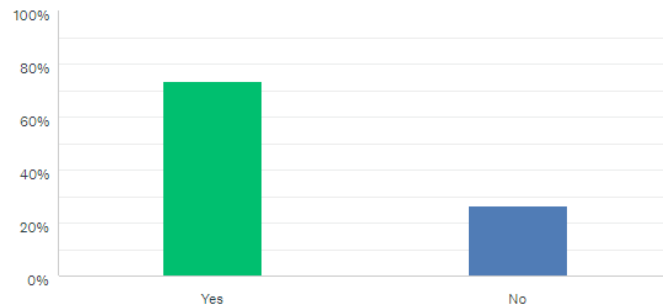

# Parent Survey – Fall 2020 Results

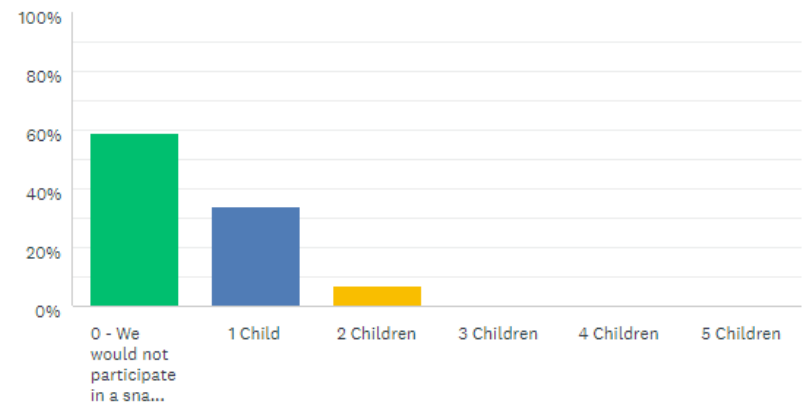

# <70% of Respondents participate in the Hot Lunch Program

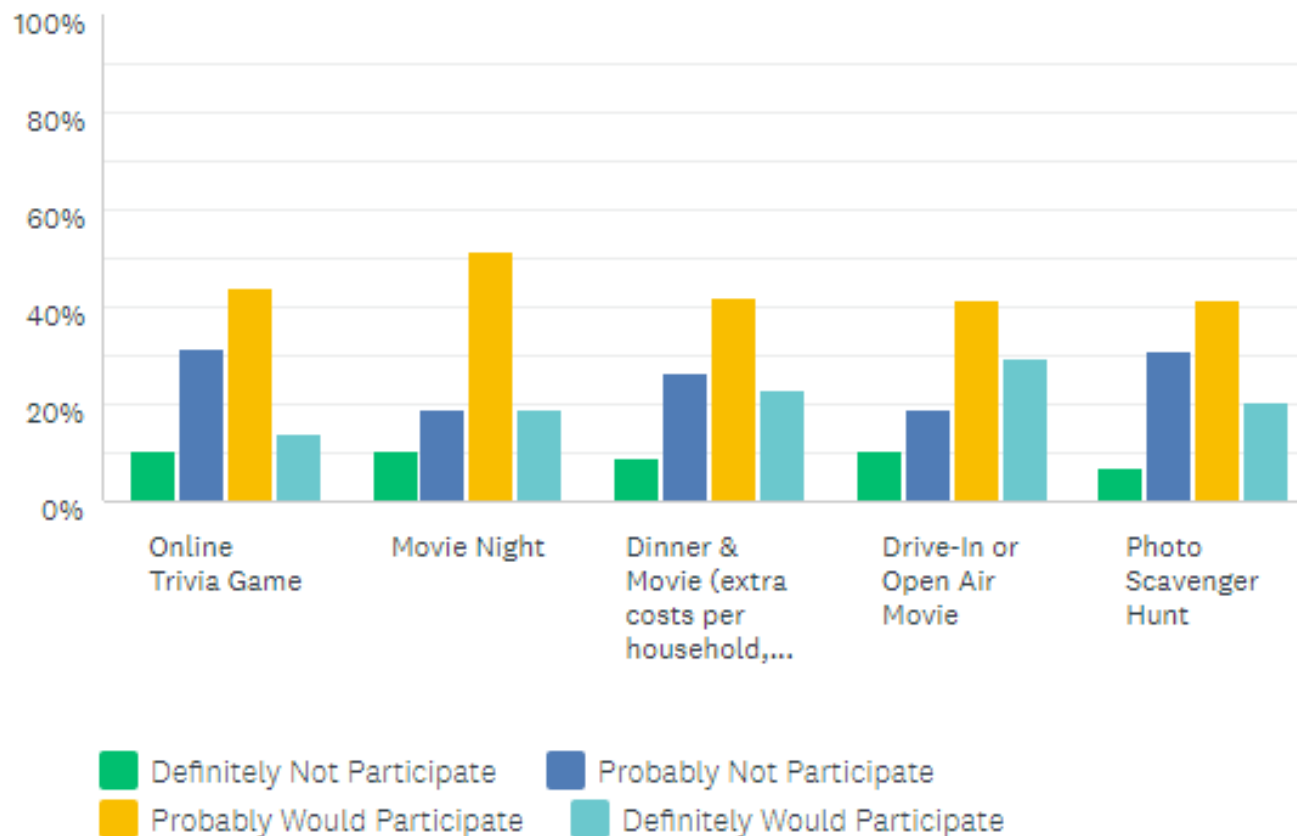

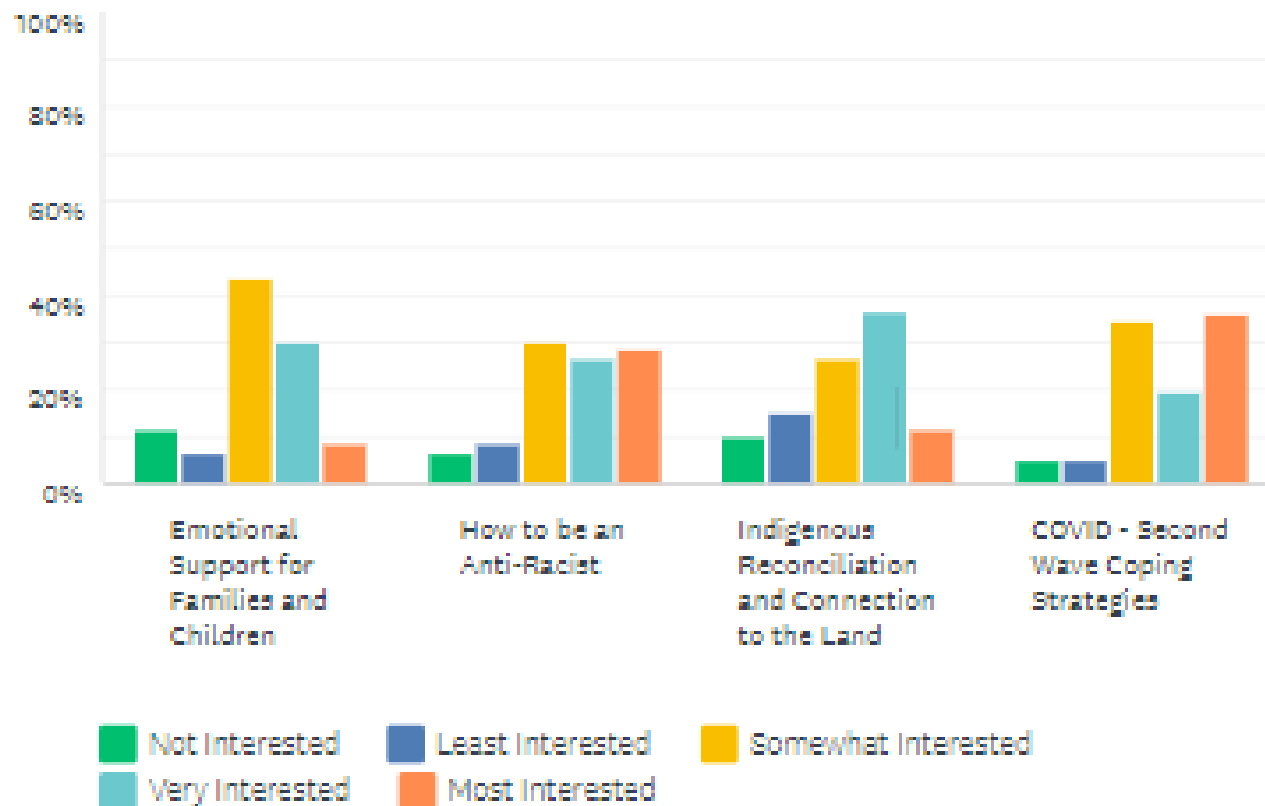
